Street Markets

the area, whilst continually changing traders to keep it fresh. This will mean a sustained increase in footfall. Research shows that customers spend 1.5 to 2 times what they spend in the street market in surrounding businesses.

What's the Latest

Fair Isle Festival 4th - 10th August

The Fair Isle Festival will run from 4/8/13 – 10/8/13 alongside the Nordic International Textile Festival, the Viking Conference and Fiddle Frenzy. It will kick off on Sunday 4th August with a Fair Isle Family Cycling Parade which will start on King Harald Street and end on Victoria Pier. Everyone is invited to wear Fair Isle, get on their bike and join in!

This will be followed by performances from Papa Stour Sword Dance and Da Shanty Yellmen. During the festival, there will be the street market, a charity dunk at Boots and an Oxjam Buskathon week. We want to encourage as many shops as possible to take part by having special offers, opening 12 - 4 on Sunday 4th and late throughout the Festival to take advantage of the extra footfall.

Working With Other Events

We have been working closely with Shetland Arts and Shetland Amenity Trust whilst developing our Fair Isle Festival. This was to make sure members could take full advantage of the additional footfall their Viking Congress, Nordic International Textile Festival and Fiddle Frenzy events will generate.

Recently, there have been a few other events taking place in the BID area that Living Lerwick hadn't been informed of. They caused issues for members, so Christena Irvine and Harry Jamieson met with SIC Councilors and relevant managers to discuss co-operation and communication on events that affect our area.

SIC agreed that from now on, they would inform Living Lerwick of any requests and applications for events within the area. This will help us inform you and do our best to turn it to our advantage.
